GUIDELINES FOR CONTRIBUTORS

BIODIVERS is a popular scientific publication of the Southeast Asian Ministers of Education Organization (SEAMEO) Southeast Asian Regional Center for Tropical Biology (BIOTROP). As a popular scientific media publication, the magazine is designed to raise awareness and literacy on latest issues on saving tropical biodiversity from the “Mountain to the Ocean” (MOTO). The scope of BIODIVERS articles covers the current thrusts of the center, namely, (1) Ecosystem Restoration and Conservation, (2) Sustainable Use Biodiversity, Bioenergy, Biotechnology, Food Security, and (3) Ecosystem Resilience in the face of global climate change.

ARTICLE SUBMISSION

All academicians, researchers, and practitioners are invited to submit popular scientific articles to BIODIVERS SEAMEO BIOTROP Magazine.

Articles should be written in **popular scientific style**—clear, engaging, and suitable for general audiences. Submissions must be in **Microsoft Word format**, using **Times New Roman, font size 10**, single-spaced on **A4 paper**. The main article consists of 1500-2500 words.

Article submitted to BIODIVERS must follow the article structure. The article structure consist of:

- 1. Primary Title**
- 2. Synopsis - a brief summary of the article (3-5 sentences)**
- 3. Author(s) - full name and institutional affiliation**
- 4. Section Title - to organize the article into subtopics**
- 5. Main Content - studies/research conducted or a review on the topic**
- 6. Future Directions / Call to Action - recommendations or proposed next steps**
- 7. Acknowledgment - optional, for those who supported the work**
- 8. Further Readings - references or suggested readings**
- 9. Short Author Biography - 2-3 sentences per author**

The submission of an article implies that it has not been submitted to other media and that, if accepted, will not be published elsewhere. All articles submitted for publication in

BIODIVERS are subjected to editorial process and revisions. All forms of plagiarism will be processed in accordance with the existing national and international legislation on publication and violations thereof are at the contributor's risk.
